School Sport Activities

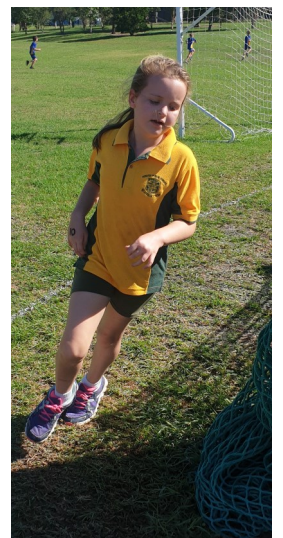
The combined Athletics carnival will be held at the beginning of term 2 on Friday 10th May. More information on this will come home later in the term.

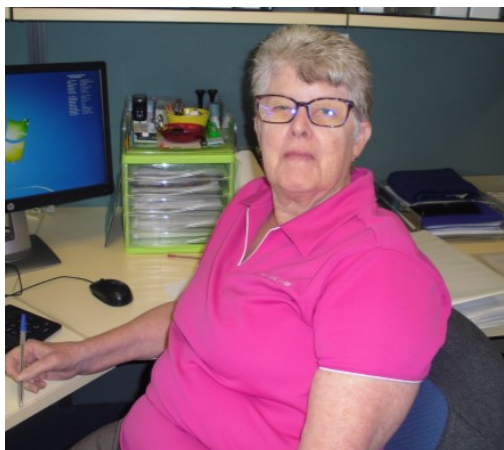

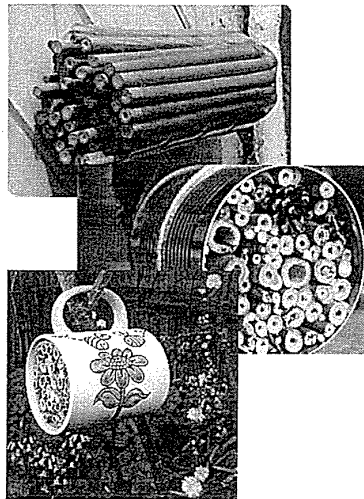
