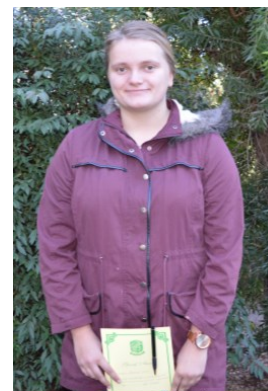
Principal's Report

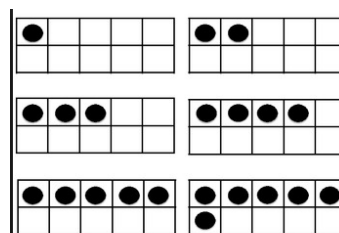


Wattle Whispers

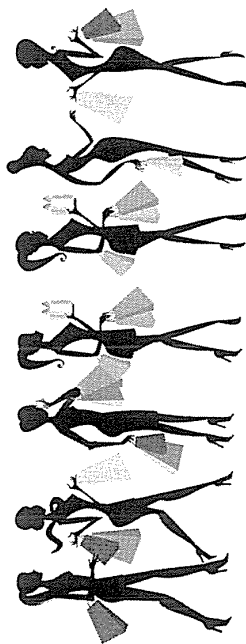
