## Learning News

The teachers will be developing their learning on Staff Development Day at Stratford on Monday 22 July. They will be developing their understanding of learning intentions and success criteria to use with the children in their learning. A *learning intention* is the statement of what students are expected to learn from the lesson and this is articulated to the children. The *success criteria* are the measures used to determine whether, and how well, the children have met the learning intention. This helps the children focus on the purpose of the activity rather than just completing the activity and allows them to take more responsibility for their own learning.

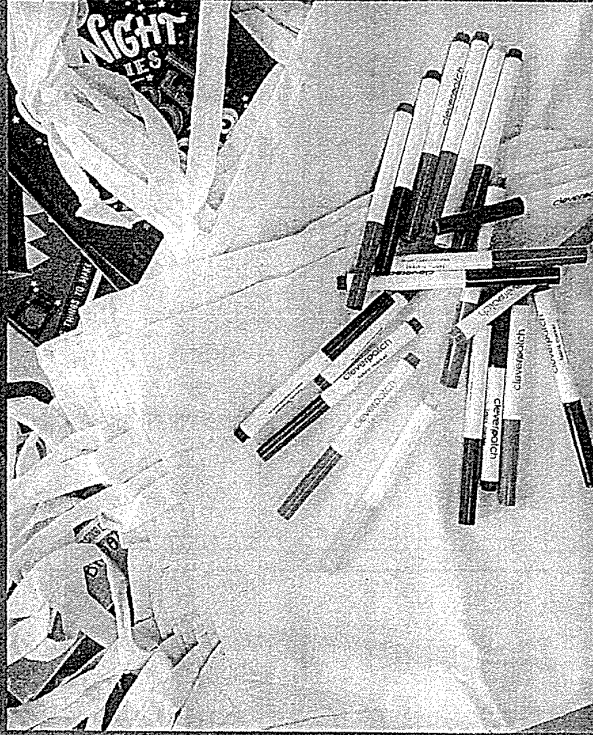
