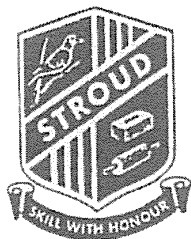


This year nights are as follows, but are subject to change depending on numbers of teams entered
