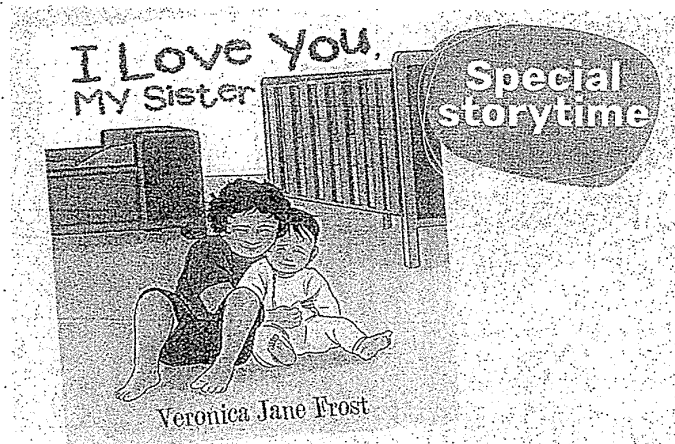

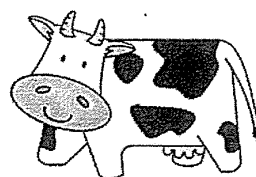
GLOUCESTER JUNIOR CATTLE SHOW
