Mobile Service Centres launched earlier this year and provide access to transactions and services that are available at Service NSW Centres. They are custom-fitted buses with dedicated Service NSW staff on board to provide support to our customers across a broad range of services including:

- Renewing a driver licence or vehicle registration
- Processing of Medical and Mobility Parking Permits
- Processing of RSA and RCG cards
- Undertaking driver knowledge tests
- Applying for births, deaths and marriages certificates
- Applications and Renewals for Working with Children Checks
- Consulting with a Cost of Living specialist for help accessing more than 40 government rebates and savings.

Mobile Service Centres will accept cashless payments by credit and debit card or cheque.

The Mobile Service Centre will visit every eight weeks. Our next two visits are scheduled for 5th September and 7th November 2019. Please check the website for the latest information on service locations and opening hours at service.nsw.gov.au/msc.
