## Learning News

### NAPLAN Results 2019

Parents in years three and five will receive their NAPLAN results today and we are looking forward to analysing the data we received to provide us with a snapshot of learning achievement at our school.

While the data we receive does allow us to look at trends in individual achievement, student growth and breakdown areas of strength and future focus, it must be viewed with a very contextual lens.

Results for individual students can, at times, be quite surprising and vary greatly to the work they do in the course of their normal learning program. Some students who are performing well academically, struggle with the format of such testing while others seem to do well with the format.

Should your child's results be different to what you expect or if you would like to discuss your child's results with his/her class teacher, feel free to make an appointment to speak to them. Your child's teacher is working with your child on a daily basis and knows a great deal more about their learning than the information gained from a one day test.
