### Coronavirus Information

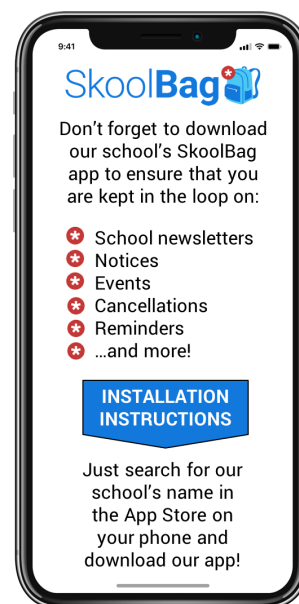

Dear Parents,

Current advice from the Australian Government Department of Health for parents and staff in relation to the Novel Coronavirus is:

- People who have been in contact with any confirmed Novel Coronavirus cases must be isolated in their home for 14 days following exposure;
- Returned travellers who have been in Hubei Province of China must be isolated in their home for 14 days after leaving Hubei Province, other than for seeking individual medical care.

Students and staff currently excluded from school are those who:

- over the last 14 days has visited the province of Hubei in central China. They should not return to school or child care services for a period of 14 days after leaving China, as the coronavirus' incubation period can be as long as two weeks or
- are under medical assessment or
- have been diagnosed with the Novel Coronavirus or
- have had close contact with a confirmed case of the Novel Coronavirus. The Ministry of Health has processes in place to identify any close contacts of cases confirmed in Australia.

In addition The NSW Ministry of Health and NSW Department of Education have recommended that:

- Any student or staff member who was in China, including Hong Kong but excluding the province of Hubei over the past 14 days is recommended not attend school or child care services for a period of 14 days after leaving, as the Novel Coronavirus' incubation period can be as long as two weeks.

Students who returned to Australia more than 14 days ago and have shown no symptoms are able to return to school this week.

There has been a small number of cases of confirmed Novel Coronavirus in New South Wales.

The Ministry of Health has processes in place to identify any close contacts of cases confirmed in Australia. Advice about not attending school would be provided to these close contacts by the Ministry of Health.

We will continue to monitor the situation closely and take advice received from NSW Ministry of Health and NSW Department of Education to ensure we are responding to the situation appropriately.

## **After School & weekends.**

Our tennis program combines our own Perceptual Motor program (4 - 5 yrs), Tennis Australia Hot Shots (5 -12 yrs), High School recreation and competition programs (12 -16 yrs) and our Leader System to deliver a state of the art tennis program.

### **Perceptual Motor program (4-5 yrs)**

A great introduction to basic tennis technique focusing on improving perceptual motor skills in a fun, play based environment.

- Mixture of cross training using other sports for tennis related activities (cricket, soccer, t-ball, basketball) helping children to further develop their hand-eye co-ordination. Tennis is still the main focus. Foam and low compression balls- smaller bats/racquets.
- Agility, tracking, manipulative skills along with body and spatial awareness.

### **Tennis Australia ANZ Hot Shots (5-12 yrs)**

The Hot Shot Red, Orange and Green balls offer players a progressive pathway through stroke production, court positioning and tactics. Teaching the framework of key skills "first" allows the more intricate skills to fall into place. Match play is also available. This is the opportunity to compete against other players.

## INFORMATION FOR COMBINED SWIMMING CARNIVAL 2020

The Combined schools swimming carnival will be held on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> February at Stroud Pool. As it is a qualification for the zone swimming carnival only 50 metre races will be held. As Booral has to wait for buses, the carnival will begin at 9.20am. There will be no time for any free swimming. Lunch orders are on the newsletter. Please return the lunch order on Monday. If your child is a non-swimmer in year two and you would rather them be at school please contact your class teacher. Please read the following information:

- **All children will need to be at school by 8.50am to be walked down to the pool at 9.05am. Children need to be picked up at the pool by 3pm. Bus children will be dropped at school in the morning and will be picked up from the pool in the afternoon to be taken home. The bus will also pick up K-2 children at school. Parents are welcome to attend. Only children 8 years and over during this year will be taken to the pool.**
- Bring hats, towel, protective clothing, recess and lunch (unless ordered), plenty of water and sunscreen. Please wear your school sports uniform. Two plastic garbage bags would also be useful in case the ground is wet and for wet clothes.
- This is a normal school day and everyone is expected to attend.
- Know the events in which you are going to participate and your age.
- Know the meaning of Junior (8, 9, 10 years), Senior (11, 12, 13 years).
- All events will be called 3 times.
- Listen carefully when races are being called. If you miss a race there will be no re-run.
- Races will be started with the following call: On Your Marks----- Get Set----- Clapper board sounded
- You must touch the wall at the end of your swim (2 hands for breaststroke).
- You will earn points for your school for every race you swim in.
- When you finish your race, stay in the water until the judges call you out of the pool.
- Make sure your name is on all clothing, personal belongings and towel.
- Girls should wear their hair tied back.
- Championship medallions will be presented to each age division (boys and girls)
- Please clean up your school area and the general surrounds before the presentation and leave the pool as it was (or better than it was).
