Premier's Reading Challenge 2021

Once again, Stroud School has joined the Premier's Reading Challenge. The Challenge is open to ALL children from Kindergarten to Year 9 and aims to encourage in students a love of reading for leisure and pleasure, and to enable students to experience quality literature. It is not a competition but a challenge to each student to read, to read more and to read more widely. All students who enter and successfully complete the Challenge will receive a Premier's Reading Challenge certificate for that year. To meet the Challenge, students must complete a set amount of reading. Some books must be chosen from the Premier's list and others may be of personal choice. See the table below:

K-2	30	25	5	K-2, 3-4, 5-6,

THE READING CHALLENGE OPENED on 1st March and CLOSES ON 20th August.

Please find the permission note attached. Please return to your child's teacher so that we can activate your child's log. When your child's log is activated, years 2-6 can access the website to log books that they read at home/school. A reading log sheet will be sent home when your child's log is activated. K-1 teacher will log books read in the classroom for students.

Fourth year (not consecutive)	Gold certificate
Fifth year, sixth year	Challenge completion certificate
Seventh year (not consecutive)	Platinum certificate
Eighth year, ninth year	Challenge completion certificate
Tenth year	Challenge completion certificate
Every year from Year 3 to Year 9 (inclusive). Therefore only Year 9 students are eligible.	Medal

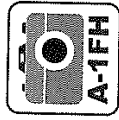

Important Information

Parents can pay for their school photos online with a credit card. There is a school code printed on the envelopes. On our sales website is a [PrePay] button. Parents can use this code to access your school's PrePay data. When the parents have paid online they will be given a receipt number to write on their envelope. They will also receive an itemised receipt by email.

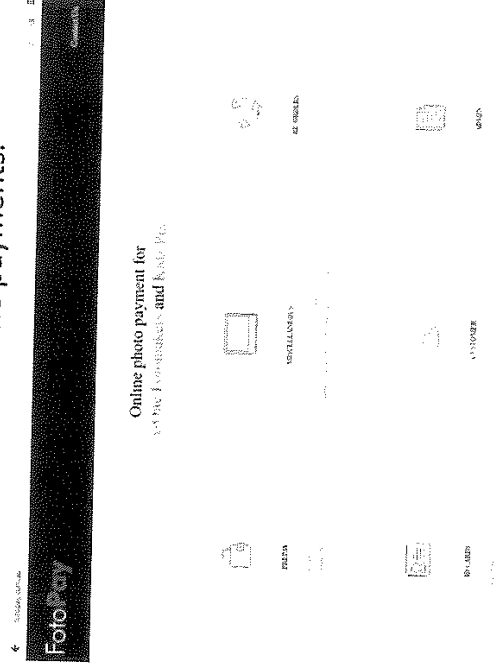

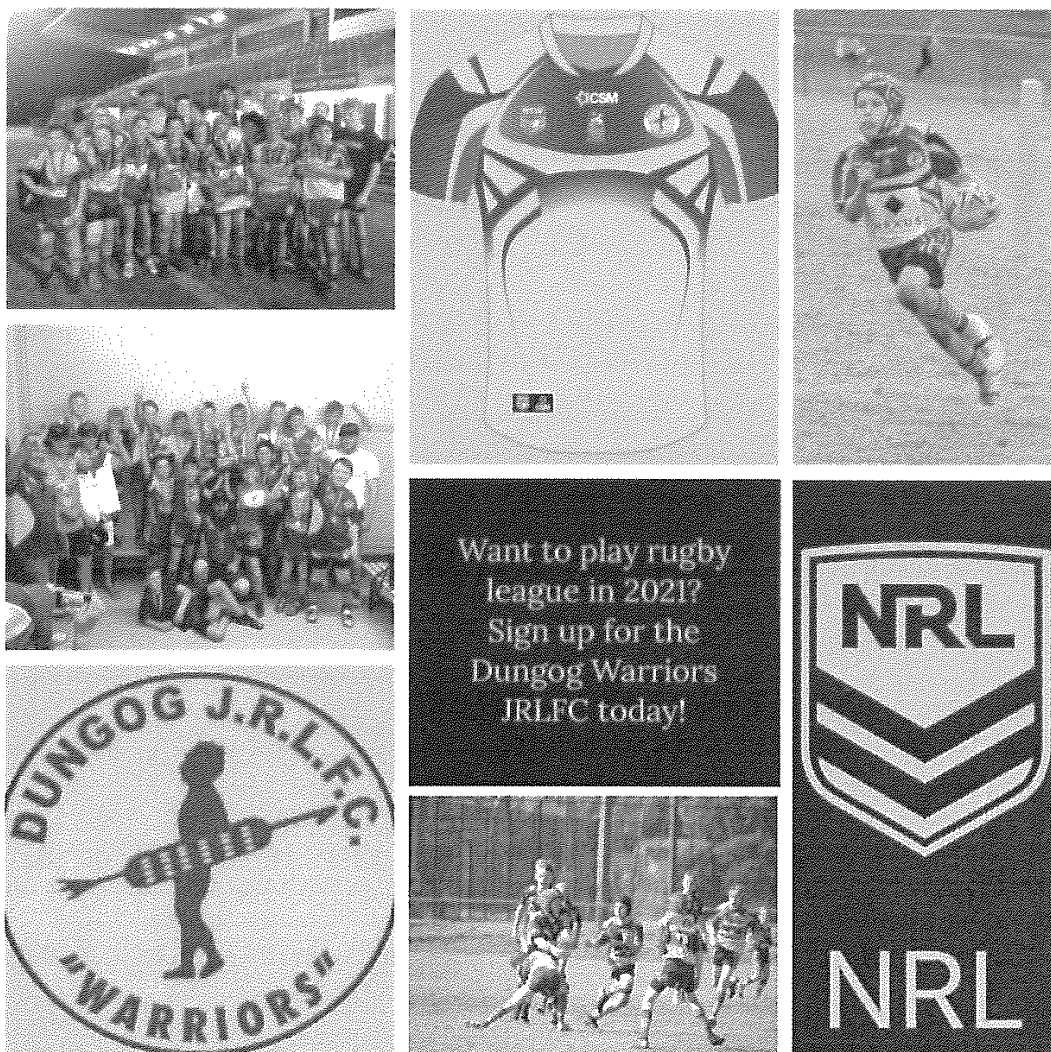
