Attendance Matters



Dear parents,

Stroud Public School are implementing an initiative to boost and support the attendance of healthy students in Term 4. **Our school target for attendance is 83% of our students attending greater than 90% of the time.** Currently, we are well below this target.

We are going to put the names of students in a barrel and every 4 weeks (20 days) draw a name from each class. These students will win a prize.

2 days or less of explained absences shows an attendance rate of 90%-100%. These students will receive 3 tickets into our draw.

3-4 explained absences shows an attendance rate of 80%-89%. These students will receive 2 tickets in the draw.

5 or more explained absences shows an attendance rate of 79% or less. These students will receive 1 ticket in the draw.

If a student had 0% attendance during the selected 4 week period (either away sick or for leave ie planned family holiday) they will miss this draw but can aim for improved attendance in the next 4 week period.

Draw 1 will run from Monday Week 1 Term 4 – Friday Week 4 Term 4.

Draw 2 will run from Monday Week 5 Term 4 until Friday Week 8 Term 4.

Students on camp, excursions or sports days are counted as attending school.


